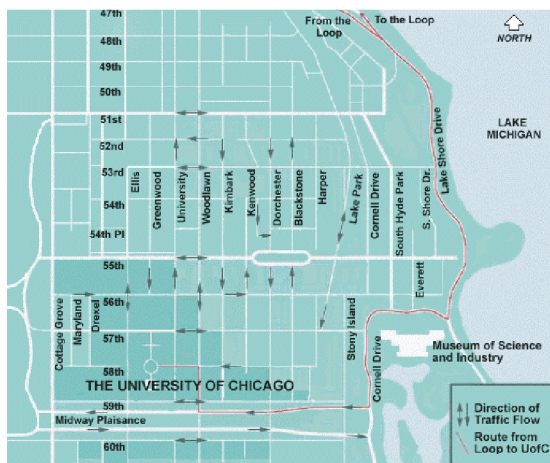

GENKIKAI
